Spring sown conventional onions in Denmark at the first of May

We don't have a total view yet, but expect a decrease in conventional onions and an increase in the ecological onions.

Considering the late spring, the season has started well. There is a good establishment, and we have had higher temperatures than normal, so we have managed to catch up with some of the lagging vegetation. We have already had warmer days this year that we had all summer last year!!

Weed control is already in progress in both ecological and conventional onions.

The sales are finally getting started, but the prices are too low and too many onions need to be sorted in the last month of the season.

It's a liability that the export is not happening during the winter time, but this is the situation when there are too many onions in Europe.
